SENATOR VENDITTE: Yes, Mr. President, members of the Legislature, one brief inquiry, if I may, Mr. Speaker, to the amendment, if I may.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You want to direct a question to Senator Simon?

SENATOR VENDITTE: Yes. Senator Simon, is there any additional fiscal impact as far as your amendment is concerned to the bill?

SENATOR VENDITTE: Not on the amendment. Mr. Speaker, would I be in order then to speak before the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have to speak on the issue before the House and the issue before the House is the adoption of the Simon amendment to LB 505.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Mr. Clerk, we are now moving the adoption of the amendment, right?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Simon amendment to the Goodrich amendment to LB 505. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted?
