SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return 538 to Select File for the specific amendment as explained by Senator Schmit. Senator Newell, your light was on. Senator Nichol, your light is on. The motion is to return the bill. All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. We are voting on the return of the bill to Select File. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill has been returned. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move for the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor of adopting the amendment as explained by Senator Schmit vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Now, Senator Schmit, do you want to move the bill back?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be readvanced, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is that the bill be readvanced to E & R for engorssment. All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is readvanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk respectfully reports that she has on this day at 3:15 p.m. presented to the Governor for his approval the following bills: 237, 249, 315 and 373.

Your committee on Education whose chairman is Senator Koch to whom is referred LB 363 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File.
