SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes you to close.

SENATOR MURPHY: The debate has been more extensive than I had anticipated but it leaves me just exactly where I was when I made the motion. Let's not create another labyrinth, another layer of educational planning and programming and agreeing and cooperation. I move the adoption of my motion to indefinitely postpone.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to indefinitely postpone 291. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. It takes 25. Have you all voted? I am going to ask once more and then call for the vote. Have you all voted? Okay, record.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 26 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Senator Koch, do you want to move advancement of the bill? The motion is to advance 291 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. A machine vote has been requested. We are voting on the advancement of 291 to E & R for engrossment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. We now move to the next item on Select File will be 103.
