

to solve a problem, but as I repeat, until you straighten out the basic problem, the equalization, the unfairness of the property tax system in this state, you are going to keep having Omaha sales tax bills and everything else.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have one minute.

SENATOR DeCAMP: The way the bill has been amended by Senator Carsten and the committee is 100% acceptable to the City of Omaha and to me as its sponsor. It is a most reasonable amendment. It has a vote of the people in it. It has a termination date that this body and those officials accept. Admittedly I did offer an amendment to try to extend it a little. I thought it might have 5 votes. It actually had 12. It kind of surprised me. I urge you to advance the bill and take note of the fact that until we address the overall property tax system we are not going to have fairness in any tax system in this state.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of LB 365 to E & R for review. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. This is the advancement of the bill to E & R for review. Have you voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Three excused. Have you all voted? Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I respectfully ask for a Call of the House, and prior to asking for a roll call vote, I would hope the Chair would take call in votes for under the Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed no. Record.
