LB 394

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis would like to suspend Rule 5, Section 10(d) to allow Senator DeCamp's name to be placed on LB 394 as cointroducer.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to suspend the rules and add Senator DeCamp's name to 394. Is that the motion?

CLERK: Yes, sir, it is.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Landis, I will recognize you and then Senator Keyes.

SENATOR LANDIS: I see no reason for debate. I have gone around the floor asking people about this issue. Its simply a matter that Senator DeCamp is familiar with the privacy legislation. He has worked for it the last six or seven years and this year he has been very helpful and instructive and the passage of 394 this far along in the process I think, in fairness to him I would like to recognize his help on this issue by having his name appear on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, do you wish to make a comment? Your light is on.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, I think this policy should be followed by all Senators on the floor of this Legislature. I know Senator DeCamp had ten bills because I took two of his so if we are going to start doing this we just as well let all Senators, so let's just change this and let every Senator have ten or twelve or fifteen bills, get his name on them.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to suspend the rules to add Senator DeCamp's name to LB 394. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay on the rule suspension, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis now has amendments to LB 394. Would you like me to read those, Senator?

SENATOR LANDIS: Would you please?

CLERK: Yes, sir. (Read Landis amendments found on page 1333 of the Legislative Journal.)
