LB 101, 101A

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 1336 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. The Call is raised. The motion now is the advancement of 101 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor... Are we ready to move the bill?

SENATOR LABEDZ: I already made the motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is to advance 101 to E & R for engrossment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. 101A, Senator Wesely.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have amendments to 101A. There are E & R amendments, Senator.

SENATOR WESELY: I move the E & R amendments to 101A.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner now moves to amend. (Read Hefner amendment found on page 1255 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I wish that you would adopt this amendment and what this amendment would do is amend the \$210,000 downward to \$150,000. This is a drop or a reduction of \$60,000. If you can remember, I supported the bill but I thought that the A bill was a little too high and I talked to the supporter of the bill, I talked to some of the other supporters and they are in favor of this amendment. Many of you here on this floor said that you wanted to watch the state's budget and this is certainly keeping an eye on this particular budget. I think that we passed a bill last year, LB 1, and we want subdivisions of government to use a 7% limit and this would be a step in the right direction and so I submit this amendment to you in all sincerity.
