LB 101A, 271

The interpreting services, \$7.00 to \$7.50 an hour and for the amount that they have already had through the CETA program, they are going to have to have at least \$53,750. Senator Merz put it in a very subtle way. We are going to have the University budget, the agency budgets here very shortly and we are going to pass those in five or ten minutes. We have spent two hours on \$150,000 and we are talking about people. I urge the support of Senator Hefner's reducing the budget from \$210,000 to \$150,000. He is reducing it \$60,000 and I approve. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hefner, do you wish to close on your...?

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I will be brief but I do like to call your attention to this is reducing the A bill, 101A, from \$210 to \$150,000. I think this is fair. I think it is realistic and I urge you to go along with this so that we can move this bill across the board.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Hefner amendment to 101A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of Senator Hefner's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted and now the motion is to advance... Senator Wesely, excuse me.

SENATOR WESELY: I move that LB 101A be advanced to E & R for engrossment as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion vote aye. I am sorry. All in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 271.

SENATOR WESELY: I move that LB 271 be...oh, you've got some amendments? Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Stoney moves to amend LB 271 and those amendments are on page 1167 of the Journal.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, when we debated this issue on General File there was a consensus and since that time I have talked with Senator
