SENATOR MARSH: I'd like a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Are you ready for a roll call vote, Senator Marsh? Proceed, Mr. Clerk, with a roll call vote.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken which may be found on Pages 1346 and 1347 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, and 20 nays, Mr. President on the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The motion carries. The amendment is adopted. We are now on the...Senator Haberman did you move to raise the Call? Senator Haberman, did you move to raise the Call?
