LB 260, 500, 505A

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 500A be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. 505A.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 505A be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 260.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 260.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Cullan now moves to amend LB 260. (Read the Cullan amendment as found on Page 1351 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, on LB 260, when we took the emergency clause off we forgot to change the other effective date of the act, which was July for the beginning of the tax, and the Revenue Department would prefer that taxes go into effect on a specific date generally at the first of the month. If we adjourn on the 25th of May, or 23rd of May, it would be the 23rd or 25th of August, and so we have simply said the 1st of September so that the tax will go into effect on a specific date. So that is all the amendment accomplishes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the Cullan amendment to LB 260 vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment's adopted. Senator Wesely.
