LB 273, 348

SENATOR MURPHY: I move the adoption of the amendment, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any further discussion on that? The motion is the adoption of the Murphy amendment as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Are we ready to advance the bill? Senator Keyes, do you want to speak on the motion to advance?

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, this is my bill, and as hurt as I am in my heart for those veterans who will be crippled and not allowed to receive this benefit unless it's service connected, I ask that you advance this bill and you have my better thoughts on it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of LB 273 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're advancing it to E & R for Review. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is advanced to E & R for Review. In the south balcony from Senator Kennedy's district it's my privilege to welcome forty 3rd and 4th grade students from District 87 School in Madison County, Mrs. Teri Daniel teacher. Where are you located so we can say hello to you? Welcome. The next bill is...the next bill is 348.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 348 was introduced by the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee and signed by the members thereof. It's a bill for an act relating to private parking lots. (Read by title LB 348.) The bill was read on January 16. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. The Committee amendments by the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee were adopted on March 19th of this year. There was a motion offered by Senator Simon. That was adopted on March 19.
