possible that that would be paid by a hundred percent state funds if the Department of Roads so chooses?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Well, you're say...well, the...you show me a highway though, a federal interstate highway that the state of Nebraska has chosen, for example, even to get the right of way without federal sharing. It's possible, for example, what you're saying is that it's legal to acquire site for the highway and then have a ninety-ten share. Now that has happened in Omaha, but I don't recall any incidence where that's happened in the state other than Omaha.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler, do you have one more question? Your time is almost up and we have four minutes left on the bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, I won't take up any more time now Mr. Speaker. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are there others that wish to speak? Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman and members, Senator Goodrich, Senator Beutler, I want to call your attention to the fiscal note that's attached to the bill, and Senator Beutler brings up a point of interpretation. Now if you'll read on down the paragraph on the blue sheet, you will see this language: There shall be no cost to the community of replacing for an example the firestation. It could be a school. It could be anything else, and I would suppose, Mr. Speaker, that in order to make clear what we intend to do in the way of who's going to pay for the cost of replacing a public facility, we ought to put some more words into the bill, and I would recommend as the Chairman of the Committee that we ought to take a look at the bill in the meantime and lay the bill aside for now and come back to it, since our time is just about up is it not, Mr. Speaker?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, we have...this bill acutally can continue on special order the first of the week if you'd like. Do you want to do it that way?

SENATOR KREMER: It's alright with me if it is with Senator Goodrich.
