SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: On behalf of the city of Omaha, Mr. Speaker and colleagues, I'd have to concur with what Senator Vickers said. I think it's extremely important for us to have some input from the city traffic division before we pass, or consider passing, a statute of this magnitude. I think Senator Vickers said it well, and I will simply concur in his remarks.

SPEAKER MARVEL: That's the end of the discussion. The motion is to advance the bill to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. I'm sorry...

CLERK: The amendment...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Tell me. Okay the motion first of all is the adoption of the Venditte amendment. All those in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the Venditte amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Now I will recognize Senator Landis and then Senator Wesely. We are out of time. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Fine, I just want to move to strike Section 2. The debate has covered the issue. I think we're ready to vote on it. That's simply to strike Section 2 of the bill. I would move to strike that at this time, and then I'll be prepared to move the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to strike Section 2 from the bill. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We're striking Section 2 of the bill. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President on the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Landis, do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes, I do, Mr. Speaker. I move LB 395 from General File to E & R Initial.
