SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted on the motion to advance the bill? We're voting on the advancement of LB 395 to E & R for Review. Do you wish to advance the bill? If you do, please vote aye. If you don't, please vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?

SENATOR LANDIS: How many are absent, Mr. Speaker?

SPEAKER MARVEL: We're voting on the advancement of the bill. Eight excused.

SENATOR LANDIS: Eight excused?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted?

SENATOR LANDIS: I'm going to hate to have to call for the House. Somebody hasn't voted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. First, we have request for an appropriations bill and then we have three short bills on appropriations for your salaries, salaries of officers of state government and Governor's emergency fund. The Clerk will read the motion from the Chairman of the Appropriations Committee.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner moves to introduce Request #904 by the Appropriations Committee.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the introduction of the bill. The bill contains the recommendations of the capital construction of the Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the vote on the request of the Appropriations Committee to introduce capital construction bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. 30 votes. We're voting on the request of the Appropriations Committee to introduce the capital construction bill. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We're voting on the proposed introduction of a capital construction bill requested by the Appropriations Committee. Record.
