SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President I move that LB 543 be advanced to E & R Initial. What this bill does, it reduces the salaries by \$7,000 for the Supreme Court as constitutional officers, and that 7,000 as I indicated this morning was transferred to another program in 542 to pay for the...some of the temporary judges that came in while existing judges were...or had retired, in order for the court to have adequate number, but it takes both bills to make the transfer as the salaries for the Supreme Court must be in a bill all by itself...or the constitutional officers must be in a bill all by itself. That's all the bill does. I move its advancement.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 543 to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced to E & R for Review. LB 555.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 555 was introduced by Senator Marvel at the request of the Governor. (Read LB 555 by title.) The bill was read on February 1. It was referred to the Appropriations Committee. It was advanced directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 555 be advanced to E & R Initial. This is a salary bill for the constitutional officers, the courts, the executive offices, all of...all salaries are set by statute, otherwise this merely appropriates that fund that the law says the salaries shall be. I move that the bill be advanced, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of LB 555 to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.
