LB 412

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a proposed rule change. Read. (See pages 1363, Legislative, Journal.) That will properly be referred to the Rules Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We will pass over Senator Keyes motion. He has circulated some changes to Senator Pirsch's bill and we will go on to LB 412. Senator Cullan, are you ready to take up your motion on LB 412?

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the motion on LB 412 is to return for a specific amendment. The amendment to LB 412 is to change the date for sunseting the funeral board. As you recall, LB 94 which would reinstate the Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors was sent back to committee and therefore those commissions will terminate in July of 1979. Therefore it is necessary to bring this bill back and change that to July of 1980 so that those boards will stay in existence while we revise LB 94 and it simply extends it one year and one year only.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return LB 412 to Select File for the specific amendment as was explained by Senator Cullan. All those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, opposed no. Record.

SENATOR CULLAN: I move for the adoption of the amendment.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the bill is returned. The motion now is to adopt the Cullan amendment as spelled out in his discussion. All those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, opposed no. It is the amendment to LB 412. We are voting on the adoption of the Cullan amendment to LB 412. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Cullan amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, do you want to move the advancement of LB 412?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I move for the advancement of LB 412 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Do you want to read the motion on LB 241?
