LB 241

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nichol moves to return LB 241 to Select File for specific amendment. Read. That amendment is on page 1348 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, a few days ago we talked about LB 241 which allows county, district and municipal judges to appoint attorneys or counsel for the indigent. There was no problem except in printing the bill up they left county in one place where they should have appointing judge allowing all of the judges to appoint counsel for indigents. I move for the return of the file for this amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion to return LB 241 to Select File vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill has been returned. Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I'd move for the adoption of the amendment that I just explained.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the adoption of the Nichol amendment to LB 241 as explained vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The amendment is adopted. Do you want to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I will move for the advancement of LB 241.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to advance LB 241 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Bill is advanced. Next bill is LB 87. Is there anyone who wishes to take this bill? Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: Was that 87?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.
