can get that answer. It is not a precedent. It is not an emergency type situation. I can't see why it can't sit there in abeyance for another year, and if next year with the proper action and the proper information before us, we can act. That is essentially why the Appropriations Committee didn't act and I think they probably acted responsibly in this matter at this point and I would hope that we not do anything with this particular item until we find out all the information that is available and will be available to us.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, we are speaking on...

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, I know.

SPEAKER MARVEL: ...on the George motion, right?

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, and Senator George I don't think thoroughly understands what is going on and I don't think Senator Schmit really meant what he said. Senator Marvel, the money never yet has been taken out of the general fund, is that right? Senator Warner, the money has never yet been taken out of the general fund, has it?

SENATOR WARNER: No. It is an authorized withdrawal from the general fund which has not been used.

SENATOR KEYES: It has not been taken out. It could be taken out next year if the federal funds are available or five years from now, as it stands, it could be taken out, if the federal funds are available but it is not taken out. We do not get the interest on it. Nobody, the money is in the general fund. All it is is an authorization to use the money when the federal funds are available and for that reason I think Senator Schmit should understand what he is doing and I know Senator George coming from north of Douglas County is very adamant against the dams and all that they stand for but I happen to be where the water comes, Senator George, and I support what is in this bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner, then Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, as has been indicated, there is some uncertainty at least in some of our minds. The language from the Game Commission indicated, in fact exact words, "Problems still exist with the federal agencies but due to the nature of this project it must be reappropriated." Whether or not there are federal funds about or possible seems to be somewhat unclear but
