One of those things, one of those proposals is for a work study by students which would cost \$2,000 to increase some of the activities of the Commission. These students would work with the Commission. I have no problem with that. In fact, I think that it probably a wise use of dollars but there are other staff that can provide these informational, can do these informational duties, and for that reason I think that the \$10,366 is unnecessary. It is far beyond the 7% limitation that we are putting on everyone else and for that reason I ask that you support my amendment.
