SENATOR WAGNER: Senator Wesely, even though I do not have an average size family, I will probably support your amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator George, do you wish to speak to the Wesely amendment? Is there any one else? Okay, the motion is on the Wesely amendment to the LB 44. Will you read the Wesely amendment again?

CLERK: Senator Wesely moves to amend LB 44 by adding a new section as follows: Effective January 1, 1980 the food sales tax credit shall be increased to \$26.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The vote is on the Wesely amendment to LB 44. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote. Excuse me, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Concerning the vote, I think I am going to try and call for a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 4 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. Senator Rumery, Senator Merz, Senator Haberman, Senator Goodrich, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Wagner, Senator Frank Lewis. Senator Wesely.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are three that are absent and Senator Rumery and Senator Merz.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, I would like to ask for a roll call vote please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you ready to call the roll? Okay, call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR WESELY: Could you please read the amendment and call the roll, Pat?
