Newell. Senator Newell, what do you wish to do? I'm going to announce the vote unless you...what?

SENATOR NEWELL: I'd like to have a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Clear the Board. The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 5 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator George, Senator Wesely, Senator Rumery, Senator Cullan, Senator Haberman, Senator Newell, Senator Hoagland, Senator Chambers, Senator Nichol, Senator Kelly. Senator George is absent. Senator Haberman's absent. Senator Hoagland's absent. That's all. Senator Sieck, would you record your presence, please? Yes?

SENATOR NEWELL: Go ahead and call the roll.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See Pages 1414 and 1415 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. The Call is raised. Is there another amendment on the desk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I have one more. Mr. President, Senator Newell moves to amend LB 587. The amendment reads as follows: (Read Newell amendment as found on Page 1415 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President and members of the body, this is the last amendment that I will offer today. The amendment basically deals with the start-up costs associated with the University's program which was called the Areas of Excellence program. It's a program that began in 1974. It was supposed to run for three years. For those of you who need mathematics help here, that goes to 1977-'78 budget. Basically it would cut \$136,602.
