SENATOR LANDIS: I will move for a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question before the House is the Call of the House. All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The House is under Call. All legislators please take their seats. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Record your presence. Senator Landis, there are sixteen absent, five excused absences and the other eleven are at the funeral. What is your pleasure?

SENATOR LANDIS: Perhaps I can withdraw the amendment since we have not a large body here and I will offer it on Select File although I will have to explain the whole thing a second time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, we will have to take a vote one way or the other on it. We can't stop in the middle of the voting.

SENATOR LANDIS: Okay, all right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to...?

SENATOR LANDIS: Well since I have explained it and I am going to have to take the same time the next time, why don't we just vote on it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want a roll call vote?

SENATOR LANDIS: No, I don't need to take the time to do that. What? Let's have a roll call vote. If it fails I will offer it on Select File. I will have to take time to explain it again, then, if we don't do it now.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on pages 1420-21 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion failed. We will leave this bill
