SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Record.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now, Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, 216 adds language. It is in section 1, requires a party requesting confidential information to pay costs of such information and Senator Kahle just asked me what price. That is set at \$5.00 an hour. If the institution can justify a greater cost it would be at that particular cost and the problem has risen in several occasions where hundreds of dollars of expenses have been gone to to issue information to requesting agencies or by court order and this would just require that they be paid for the actual costs in preparing that information and I would move the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kahle.

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Speaker, members, one more question of Senator Reutzel. The court order part, would that fee be exactly the same for court required information as it would for an individual? I guess what I need to know is...

SENATOR REUTZEL: What is your question again?

SENATOR KAHLE: If the request is court ordered, is the fee the same or can this charge be charged by the court?

SENATOR RUETZEL: The banking counsel just said that his interpretation of the bill as written is that if it is under court order that requesting party still has to pay that fee.

SENATOR KAHLE: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Senator Reutzel, I have a question if you would yield.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Sure.
