LB 342, 478, 536

CLERK: (Read LB 342 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1432 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 2 nays, 5 excused and not voting and 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Before we begin the next bill it is my pleasure to introduce from Senator Burrows district, in the South balcony, forty-five fourth grade students from Paddock-Lee School, Beatrice, Nebraska, and their teacher, Don Haberman. Will you raise your hands and show us where you are so we can say good morning to you? I have one other comment to make to you. The constitution of the State of Nebraska requires that every bill that this Legislature passes must be read on what we call Final Reading, word for word. So that is what the Clerk is doing and the Legislature has gone over these bills before so if the situation seems a little confusing, this is what the constitution asks for. That is the reason we do it this way. We have three more bills to read before we recess for noon. So the Clerk will now read LB 478.

CLERK: (Read LB 478 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. LB 478. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1433 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting and 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. Next bill, LB 536.
