We are talking now in terms of protecting society and I think that if you are going to build a procedure by which you examine the person to determine whether he or she is suitable for release after having been convicted of a certain offense, that same standard should apply to any individual, remember what I am saying, who has committed acts of violence against the person of others, not stealing or larceny or any of those other things. I am asking that you adopt this amendment.
