

structure to be constructed, it is a maintenance building, at their central maintenance complex that \$40,000 and this is a combination of NORDA funds and game funds that combination reflecting the approximate use that the building would have as far as these two fund sources are concerned. The Department of Corrections, the only new construction authorized aside from what we have in the reaffirmation bill which is a major construction of course, but in this is \$28,800 which is for again life safety at all of the various institutions. There is a \$15,000 appropriation for a vocational training building at the Lincoln Medium Minimum plant with an authorization of \$221,000 for construction in '80-'81. There is a new structure to be constructed at Geneva which is a control and visitor center providing a need that they now do not have at that particular institution. There are some miscellaneous improvements in the way of equipment for the penitentiary and at York \$26,000 and also at the penitentiary there is some ventilation equipment at \$27,000 but this is equipment that will and can be used in the new structure, the maximum structure as it is completed. Another item which is for '80-'81 a year from now is a replacement of Channel 19 transmitter at Norfolk which is a combination of General Fund money a \$175,000 plus \$525,000 of federal funds that needs to be placed in the bill this year however in order to be able to qualify for the application of those federal funds. The case of the Board of Trustees is \$150,000 of miscellaneous renovations for them, the other specific items is track improvements at Chadron at \$95,000, a library addition planning at Kearney at \$25,000; modification at Founders Hall at Kearney a \$125,000 for the coming fiscal year and \$170,000 for '80-'81. The Nebraska Safety Center which was legislation enacted last year has a appropriation of \$20,000 this year with an appropriation of \$320,000 for the following year '80-'81. At Peru there is repair of a drainage system at \$80,000 which is the underground drainage system which is collapsing and needs to be replaced. Then there is funds for renovation of Education Humanities Building at Wayne, \$25,000 for this year with an authorization of \$771,000 '80-'81 and \$703,000 for '81-'82. The final item for state colleges \$77,000 for street and parking improvements at Wayne. Relative to the University of Nebraska the four items included one at the level at \$215,000 is at Curtis, some animal holding units but it is in relation to their veterinary science program. There is a million, hundred thousand for this year with an addition million, six hundred thousand for '80-'81 to renovate the Ag Engineering Building at UNL. There is an amount of \$750,000 this year and nearly a million five for '80-'81 to renovate the Eppley Building at the University of Nebraska in Omaha and the final item is
