But there is. I propose that we don't move this bill either. I propose that we hold the bill on Select File so that each member can do an in depth detailed study of the budget committee and I..and their appropriations and I apologize for not doing it. I apologize for my misplaced faith in that committee. Because I know you all personally and I know that you all work hard at it. I thought that you had arrived at a decision. But obviously that decision is not uniform and there is some disagreement and we probably should debate each and everyone of those disagreement issues. Mr. Chairman, with those remarks, it has always been my nature to offer substantive amendments, and those will be forthcoming on Tuesday. I ask unanimous consent to withdraw the one at hand.
