CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Murphy's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Murphy, do you want to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR MURPHY: I move the bill be readvanced to E & R Engrossing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is readvanced. The next item on the agenda is LR 51. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 51 was offered by Senator Koch. (Read LR 51.) Mr. President that resolution is on Page 1411 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, for the edification of the body, these two young people have an outstanding record of achievement in the area of debate forensics. Oftentimes we recognize the athletes and the champions of this state but many times we fail to recognize the achievements of others that may be equally great and sometimes even more important. Therefore, I would hope this body would endorse this resolution to Mr. Johnson and Miss Beeder with congratulations and good wishes for the future. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I ask unanimous consent to join Senator Koch as the co-author of this resolution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: So ordered. The motion is the adoption of LR 51. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the resolution, Mr. President.
