SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler, do you have any other comments?

SENATOR BEUTLER: No, I have no further comments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return LB 356 to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is to return the bill. It needs 25 votes. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is returned. Senator Beutler, do you want to move the adoption of the amendment?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I will now move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Beutler amendment as explained. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: I would sooner have Senator Beutler print his amendment in the Journal rather than try to deal with it in this type of situation. I think it has to be reviewed by the Chairman of this Committee along with other members. If someone voted to put this bill on the floor I see them voting green on the Board, which I don't understand. Obviously they didn't take time to understand the bill when it came on the floor in the first place, so therefore I suggest that Senator Beutler put his amendment in the Journal and we'll take up this bill at a later time after we've had a chance to visit with our legal counsel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I have no objection, Mr. Speaker, to printing it in the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the unanimous consent request to print the Beutler amendment to 356 in the Journal. No objection. So ordered. The Clerk will read 376 on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read on Final LB 376.)
