SENATOR WARNER: I think essentially they operate the same.

SENATOR MURPHY: Fine. Thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: Mechanically it is.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the return of LB 560 to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is returned. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment as I have explained it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Warner amendment as explained. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, do you want to move the bill back to E & R for Engrossment? I'm sorry, excuse me, I got ahead of myself.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 560 be re-advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. The Clerk will read the final bill for this morning on Final Reading, LB 578.

CLERK: (Read on Final LB 578.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.
