says that entry cannot be made directly to the Supreme Court and to protect the bill from an unconstitutional position he suggested that we correct that and instead of making an initial appeal to the Supreme Court, it will go to the District Court. That is the sole purpose of that amendment and I move its adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy. You have an amendment to 331.

SENATOR MURPHY: Mr. Chairman, I again would move the adoption of the amendment. I have explained it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Murphy amendment to 331. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the first Murphy amendment to LB 331. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting on Murphy amendment #1 to LB 331. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the first Murphy amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried and the amendment is adopted. Do you have amendment #2?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Murphy moves to amend LB 331 by adding the emergency clause.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: I believe it needs no discussion, Mr. President. I would ask that the emergency clause be added to this bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is in Murphy amendment #2 is to add the emergency clause to 331. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? We are voting on Murphy amendment #2 to LB 331. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the second Murphy amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Now, amendment #3.
