All legislators please return to your seats, record your presence. Unauthorized personnel as per usual, please leave the floor when we are under Call. How many are absent, Mr. Clerk? Senator Sieck, Senator Murphy, Senator Landis, Senator Koch, Senator Wesely, Senator Lamb, Senator Hefner, Senator Kremer, Senator Merz, Senator DeCamp, Senator Dworak, Senator Cullan, Senator Haberman, Senator Goodrich, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Newell, Senator Frank Lewis, Senator Nichol, Senator Reutzel and Senator Clark. We are awaiting your vote on the Newell amendment to the Fowler amendment to LB 348. The Clerk is authorized to accept call in votes.

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting aye; Senator Johnson voting aye, Senator Wesely voting aye; Senator Vickers voting aye; Senator Lamb voting aye; Senator Marsh voting aye; Senator Dworak voting aye; Senator Sieck voting aye; Senator Merz voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Newell amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Newell amendment is adopted. Now we move the Fowler amendment as amended. The motion is the Fowler amendment as amended by the Newell amendment to LB 348. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. This is the Fowler amendment as amended by the Newell amendment amending LB 348. Have you all voted? One more time, we are voting on the Fowler amendment as amended by the Newell amendment to 348. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 12 nays on adoption of the Fowler amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill?
