CLERK: Senator DeCamp voting aye; Senator Reutzel voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is the advancement of the bill to E & R for review. Okay, Senator Newell.

CLERK: Senator Koch changing from no to yes.

SENATOR NEWELL: For purposes of reconsideration. How close are we? Is anybody paying any attention?

CLERK: Senator Vickers changing from no to yes. Senator Clark voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Now if you will hold your patience until Senator Warner has time to request the introduction of two bills we will then adjourn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner moves for the introduction of Request #925 by the Appropriations Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the...which one did you read, Pat?

CLERK: 925, Senator.

SENATOR WARNER: 925 is the intent languages. This one deals only with the language for the accelerated water planning review process. The other request is the general intent language for all of the appropriation bills. I move the bill's introduction, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the introduction of the bill as per the request of Senator Warner. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the introduction of the bill. (Read by title for the first time, LB 595.)
