LB 227, 358

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The bill is returned. Senator Warner, we just as well take it up right now so we can move it on its way. The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment and unless there is further discussion, why...

PRESIDENT: All right. The motion is that the amendment is before you. Is there any discussion on the amendment? If not then, that will constitute your opening and your close on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 2 nays on the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 227 be readvanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB 227 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 227 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. We are now back on Final Reading and all members will again return to their desks. I remind you, you are still on Final Reading and the Chair advised me there is another motion. Is this on LB 358?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion, Mr. Clerk. There is a motion on LB 358.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Brennan moves to return LB 358 to Select File for specific amendment. Read amendment offered by Senator Brennan on page 1519, Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Brennan.

SENATOR BRENNAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the body, I am asking to return this bill because there is several correlating amendments in this bill that correlated with LB 114 which has been stalled on Final Reading because of the A bill and I would ask that this be returned and the
