PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion on Senator Brennan's motion to return? Seeing none, I guess that will constitute your close. The motion then is the return of LB 358 for the purpose of that specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SENATOR BRENNAN: I move this bill be readvanced.

PRESIDENT: All right. The motion carries. The bill is returned. Now we have to adopt the amendment.

SENATOR BRENNAN: Adopt the amendment, sir.

PRESIDENT: So we are now on the amendment. Motion then by Senator Brennan is to adopt the amendment. Is there any further discussion? That will constitute your close, Senator Brennan. The motion then is to adopt the amendment on LB 358. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Senator Brennan.

SENATOR BRENNAN: I move that this bill be readvanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion then is to readvance LB 358 to E & R for engrossment. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 358 is advanced to E & R engrossment.

SENATOR BRENNAN: Mr. Speaker, I would ask that this bill be...unanimous consent to bracket this bill behind 114. Does that have to be returned before....
