LB 52, 59, 135, 136

Reading. Proceed with the reading, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 52 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 52 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 1520 and 1521, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 30 ayes, 13 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 52 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 59.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 59 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 59 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 1521 and 1522, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 34 ayes, 4 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 6 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 59 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 135.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 135 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 135 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1522, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 41 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 135 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 136.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Rumery moves to return LB 136 to Select File for specific amendment, that amendment being to add the emergency clause.
