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have to pay another penny, special fuel tax, for the construction and the financing of a gasohol plant when there isn't any relationship at all to gasohol to the diesel fuel being burned in these trucks? Our state highway system is in a deplorable condition. In fact, there were 120 projects that were delayed from the 1973 program because of a shortage of funds. Our county roads and bridges are in deplorable condition. They need more money. Our villages and cities need more money for the construction of roads. I was talking to you about the 120 projects that were delayed in the 1973 program and five of these projects were in my legislative district, and in visiting the people that are affected by the delay of these projects, they feel that we should use the gas tax money for the repair and the rebuilding of these roads, and don't get me wrong, folks, I support the gasohol program but I think we need to figure out a different way to finance it. Also with the price of gasoline going up, I think that these alcohol plants will be feasible. I think what we need to do is let the free enterprise system get involved in this and take it from there. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator DeCamp began to address some of the concerns that individuals had about this particular measure, and if he would respond to a couple of questions, I will be in a position to provide him some of my time to perhaps continue to answer some of those questions.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp, will you respond?

SENATOR STONEY: Senator DeCamp, I think that, without being repetitive, some of the things that Senator Nichol referred to as well as Senator Dworak concern me and I am sure other members in the body also. Most importantly, of course, I feel the cost effectiveness and the economic feasibility is a major factor but I also have one serious reservation and that deals with the constitutionality of accomplishing what we are attempting to do here with this bill, are you in a position to address that?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, and Senator Schmit specifically requested me, and I think he will bring it up a little later, in the closing on the amendment he asked me if I would make the closing and address a bunch of these things and I have agreed to, if you want to do it that way.
