7 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 575 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 15.

CLERK: (Read on Final LB 15.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 15 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote may be found on Page 1549 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 2 nays, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 15 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 103.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: Senator Schmit, moves to return LB 103 to Select File for a specific amendment, that amendment being to strike the enacting clause.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I did offer that motion but I know that we're very busy and I think that perhaps the bill has been discussed in great detail and I feel that at this time it would do no good to offer a motion to return the bill except to delay the activities of the Legislature even further. I'm going to vote against the bill, but I ask unanimous consent to remove that motion.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the motion is withdrawn. We will proceed then with the Final Reading of LB 103, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read on Final LB 103.)
