I am informed that Congressman Cavanaugh is a constituent of Senator Labeledz so we keep the record straight. Have you all recorded your presence? Senator Kennedy. Senator Goodrich, Senator Brennan, Senator Marsh, you need to record your presence. Senator Lamb, I think we have all legislators. Do you want to proceed with a roll call? Will all legislators please take your seats? We cannot proceed with a roll call until you are all in your seats. We will not proceed with the roll call until all legislators are in their seats. All legislators, please be in their seats. We are not going to start the roll call until they are. The rule is not limited to just a few. The rule includes everybody. Will all legislators please take their seats so we can proceed with a roll call on LB 226? Okay, Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 1566 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.
