Mr. Sergeant at Arms, Senator Kremer and Senator Chambers are still absent. Senator Kremer cannot be located and Senator Chambers. May we go on with the roll call?

SENATOR LEWIS: Sure. That is a wash. Yes, call the roll.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, call the roll. We are voting on the second Lewis amendment to LB 138. Right? The Lewis amendment to the committee amendments to 138. Call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 1586 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Lewis, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR LEWIS: When the vote is announced I would like that to be a record vote in case it is not.

CLERK: It will be Senator.

SENATOR LEWIS: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Announce the vote.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. What is the next...?

CLERK: We have to adopt the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan, do you wish to move the adoption of the committee amendments?

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, quickly, I move the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of adoption of the committee... Okay, I have got three lights on. Do you want to speak to this motion or do you want to speak to the bill as a whole before it is either advanced or whatever happens? Senator Warner, do you wish to speak to this motion? Okay.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I am going on the assumption that there may be a question called so there won't be another opportunity. I want to first point out that I am speaking against the adoption of the committee amendments and it is not an easy position for me. I have got at least a sixteen
