

SENATOR SIMON: Thank you, Senator Newell, my memory is getting more refreshed all of the time. I do recall discussing these amendments. I opposed the amendments and let me state why. And the amendments were discussed by the committee whether it was in executive session or informally and the majority of the people on the committee did not feel that it was necessary to adopt these amendments. So, understand members of the Legislature that Senator Newell is offering these on his own. The majority of the members, of that particular committee that Senator Newell chairs did not support these amendments and this is how Senator Newell is bringing them to the floor. The amendments state and the amendments as Senator Newell said are found on page 1328 of the Journal, that if the merchant does not have a sufficient quantity of merchandise to meet reasonable expected demand that they shall be exempt. I guess the concern that I have is that an individual can advertise a particular product for sale knowing full well that they only have a quantity of five of that particular item. Going to sell suits, three piece suits, for \$49.95. Senator Kahle said that he would take three. But, Senator Kahle, they only have five in the whole store and you were not the first one there so you are out of luck. Gee, that is too bad. Now, I'm not positive whether or not, but I think that this might come under the Deceptive Practices Act, but at this point I am not prepared to vote for the amendment. I guess, Senator Newell, I am saying, I would ask that perhaps you might consider withdrawing the amendment and lets take a look at it on Select File and I can get my questions answered by the Attorney General's office. If the practices that the Attorney General's office covers would take care of these, if the deceptive practices would cover all of the provisions that I am concerned about, would you be willing to do that?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I'll withdraw the amendments and... so that we can get it....

SENATOR SIMON: Thank you.

SENATOR NEWELL:....a understanding of everything.

SENATOR SIMON: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: No objection? The amendments are withdrawn. Senator Johnson, do you have a question of Senator Newell?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes I do, Mr. Speaker.
