SPEAKER MARVEL: Your time is up. The bill goes to the bottom of its particular column. We now go to LB 312 which is a banking bill and Senator DeCamp will take that bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 312 was introduced by the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee and signed by the members thereof. (read bill) There are committee amendments by Senator DeCamp's Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee, Mr. President.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Okay now, you have got the second version of amendments. Remember it was referred back to committee and came back out again.

CLERK: I have Request #2866 that was my latest request.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Is that right? Okay, move adoption of the committee amendments. Adopt the amendment and then I will explain them. They become the bill, is that okay?

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendment. Senator Keyes, do you wish to speak on the committee amendments? Senator Cullan, your light is on. Motion is the adoption of the committee amendments. Any further discussion? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. We are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments which actually are the bill. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 312. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the committee amendments are adopted. Senator DeCamp.
