SENATOR NEWELL: Oh, okay, thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 267 to E & R Review all those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, could I have a Call of the House please?

As long as you are all in your seats the Clerk may accept call in votes. Please record your presence. Senator Newell, what do you wish to do, it is getting late. It is 4:00 o'clock.

SENATOR NEWELL: How many are excused?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Twelve.

SENATOR NEWELL: Twelve and 49 and somebody hasn't pushed their button.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cope, Senator Schmit, Senator Beutler, Senator Haberman.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, could we call the roll?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 13 ayes, 21 nays, 3 present and not voting and 12 excused and not voting. Vote appears on pages 1596-1597 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Call is raised. Motion is lost. The bill is not advanced. I wish to, Senator Carsten has a motion before we adjourn. Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Motion, Mr. President?

SPEAKER MARVEL: I'm sorry, you have an announcement.
