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listen if we can just hustle through here and get those guys out of here and get them at home, then we can continue to do what we've done and that's not to do anything about the problem. So I think that they ought to know. First of all, there's a vehicle ready, willing and available to carry out the intent I thought of what this Legislature said many times in terms of that particular facility in south Omaha. So I know Senator DeCamp would like to go along with this, and Senator Schmit if you don't mind, I would propose we simply bring the bill back and then just leave it there and have it in place and ready for amendment at the proper time, if that's an acceptable solution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Before we go to Senator Kremer, in the south balcony I would like to introduce two groups. One group comes from Senator Hasebroock's district, twenty-four 4th grade students, two teachers and three parents from Stanton, Nebraska Grade School, Wanda Publow is the elementary teacher in the area of Social Studies. Where are you located? Okay, that's the first group. And then from Senator Schmit's district fifteen students, kindergarten through eighth grade from District 23, Saunders County, Wahoo, Nebraska, one teacher, three parents, the teacher, Mrs. Robert L. Woita. Where are you located? There you are. Okay. Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman and members, I for one am going to support the Venditte proposition to bring the bill back. Senator Venditte, I'm not sure you go far enough. I'm not sure because I wasn't listening carefully enough when you read your amendment if you relate this problem only to Omaha and the bale site. All you have to do is live next to a "dump", for about twenty years, and you become increasingly aware of the problem with rats and smoke and anything that you can talk about. I think we ought to bring the bill back or pass over the bill and work with it. I think the Ag and Environment Committee has worked on this, and I'm going to vote to bring it back, and what we do with it on Select File we will make the determination then, but Senator Venditte has pointed out a problem that's real today, and all you have to do is live somewhere in the vicinity where one of these are in operation and believe me you want some action of some kind. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? The question before the House is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.
