is our salaries that we want this commission for. I'm willing to say that, but if we have to play a grand scheme which Senator Reutzel wants to play, lets not perpetuate the wrong by saying that the judiciary all the way down to the lowly municipal courts and the county courts should be in this grand scheme. For that reason I would like to take amendment number two, I would like to have it accepted which strikes the judiciary and we will play this grand scheme on a little more reasonable manner. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is the adoption of the Newell amendments, no, Senator Newell, you have three different parts to your amendment. You are proposing first of all that we strike the members of the judiciary, is that right?

SENATOR NEWELL: That is correct. That is amendment number two, that is labeled number two on the amendments and then I would like to take one and three together since they are just cleaning up language and allowing us to cut some of the language out of the proposal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I think that you have made it clear as long as you have extracted number two that we ought to also extract number one and three. It would be clearer that way.

SENATOR NEWELL: I am saying that....I want to take two first.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I understand, and that is fine.

SENATOR NEWELL: Okay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: But when it comes to the other two the Chair feels that it would be fairer to the Legislature if we took these one at a time.

SENATOR NEWELL: Fine, that is fine.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Because it is.....okay, all right. The motion is the Newell amendment which would strike the judiciary from the bill. Senator Koch, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR KOCH: A question of the Chair.
