SPEAKER MARVEL: I would rather take them all together but, he wants to for clarification....

SENATOR KOCH: Well, Mr. Speaker, what has happened since it is obvious that he has realized the disfavor he struck the one section which received the major treatment. In speaking to the whole amendment several of us pushed our buttons and took them off when the question was called. Otherwise we would be willing to speak to the amendment since we are going to divide them now because they are equally important.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Your point is well taken.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, what I think that we need to do in view of that fact is that to take all three of them at once.

SENATOR NEWELL: Take all three of them at the same time?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch, will you clarify once again?

SENATOR KOCH: Well I am suggesting, Mr. Speaker, that we divide the issue and debate the other two issues that he wants to try and pass before this body, because I had my button on. There was no sense for me to speak to the whole amendment since Senator Lewis and others covered it succinctly but now since we are going to take out the part that Senator Newell finds is meeting disfavor either we vote on it as a whole or we take it up individually with additional debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch and Senator Newell, can you come up here a minute please. Okay, there are three parts to the Newell amendment. The first part where debate has ceased has to do with striking the words "members of the judiciary" and this is the first issue. Then we will go separately to amendment one and amendment three. So the vote at the moment is whether or not you wish to adopt the Newell amendment to LB 99 which on page two that strikes "members of the judiciary". All those in favor of the adoption of that amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? One more time, have you all voted? Okay, the Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 23 nays on the second Newell amendment.
