SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Mr. Clerk. Do you have, lets see we had these amendments offered and we now are on Senator Maresh's... Senator Maresh, you had two sets of amendments. You are asking unanimous consent to withdraw one of them?

SENATOR MARESH: Yes, Mr. Speaker. I wish to consider only one of these amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What does the...read the Maresh amendment.

CLERK: Read Maresh amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me just a minute so that we can keep things fairly clear. We are amending at the moment the De Camp amendments which are found where?

CLERK: They were printed separately, Mr. President, and I believe that the members can find them in their bill books.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Chair recognizes Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Yes, Mr. Speaker, what this does it adds liquor and wine to the items that will be taxed to provide funding. I move that the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now just a moment. The motion is the adoption of the Maresh amendment to the DeCamp amendments. Senator Dworak, do you wish to be recognized on the Maresh amendment? Senator Fowler, do you, no your light is off. Senator Schmit, do you wish to be recognized to the...Senator Frank Lewis, do you wish to be recognized? Okay. All right the motion is the adoption of the Maresh amendments to the DeCamp amendments. All those in favor of the Maresh...read the amendment again, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read Maresh amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the Maresh amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? This takes a majority of those voting. Record the vote.

CLERK: 21 ayes, no nays on the motion to adopt, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is adopted and the Maresh amendment to the DeCamp amendments is approved. What is the next amendment, Mr. Clerk? Okay, the motion now before the House is the DeCamp amendments as amended by the Maresh amendment. Senator Johnson, do you wish to be recognized on that?
