LB 505, 495

CLERK: Read LB 505

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, may I hold this off until Senator Simon gets here as my amendment is tied in with some that he has.

PRESIDENT: You...Speaker Marvel. Senator Haberman wants to pass over his motion at this time.

SENATOR HABERMAN: The problem is that my amendment is tied into the green copy and Senator Simon's amendments are tied into the other copy and he has three others that are merely technical amendments that change a little bit of wording. They don't affect the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is Senator Simon excused?

PRESIDENT: He said that he would be here sooner than that. He said about 9.....

PRESIDENT: We will then go to LB 495. Mr. Clerk do you want to read the....

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman moves to return LB 495 to Select File for specific amendment. (Read amendment).

PRESIDENT: What page was that?

CLERK: The Fowler amendment is found on Page 1139.

PRESIDENT: 1139. The Chair recognizes Senator Haberman.
