appropriation process and any agency adjustment that is necessary be reflected in appropriations to recognize increase of the rental for the state billings involved. The third amendment puts back in some language as to what will be required, the document, the cost for reimbursement by state employees and it puts in much of the language that was in the bill. It was taken out. It puts back in as a maximum requirement but it would permit something lesser than that requirement. Then the last amendment merely clarifies that the existing cash fund and on July 1, 1979, will be transferred to this new revolving fund and then there is an operative date put on the act of July 1, 1979, so that it will coincide with the fiscal year and the transfer in funds takes place at that time. I would move adoption of the amendments. As I have indicated, they are nothing more than clarifications of what the bill originally does and was explained on General File.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Warner amendments to LB 576. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the Warner amendment to LB 576. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.
