LB 576A, 224

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the Warner amendment to LB 576A. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is adopted. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move that LB 576A be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me, we are going to go back now. I am sorry. We have LB 224 fixed up. Do we have an amendment to 224 or what is it.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I stopped the bill to be sure that the wording is correct. I talked to Terry Micek over at the Liquor Commission and they have a resident's agents deal for other counties and so we should go ahead and proceed with 224 and its amendments and thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: LB 224 does not need any changes then, is that....
