LB 251, 492

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 251 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. It is nice to do business with you, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I don't have the Attorney General's opinion I need on that so I will hold the amendments at the present time and wait until I get it because I know that it is a major amendment. I wouldn't want to stall the bill now, but hopefully at the proper time, Sam will come out strongly supporting taxing the railroads so we can build some more trestles.

SENATOR WESELY: I move that LB 492 be returned to E & R for engrossment to correct an engrossing error.

SPEAKER MARVEL: 492? This is for an E & R....

SENATOR WESELY: An E & R engrossing error.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. What is the number of the bill, 492? From what?

SENATOR WESELY: Final Reading back to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return the bill from Final Reading for the purposes of clearing up E & R amendments, is that it? And the number is 492?

SENATOR WESELY: That is right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. There are E & R problems with the bill and that is why it is being returned. Have you all voted? 492. Have you all voted? Record.
